



Nebraska Iowa Electrical Council Code Classes Fall, 2018 • General Information

Times: All classes will meet from 9:00 a.m. - Noon and 1:00 - 4:00 p.m.

Notes: •**Nebraska:** All licenses expire December 31, 2018.
You must complete all twelve (12) hours of continuing education by that date or retake the test.
There is no grace period.

•**Iowa:** You have until December 31, 2019 to complete all eighteen (18) hours of continuing education or retake the test.
There is no grace period.

Cost: **NIEC Member** companies' employees - \$90.00 per person per class
Non-member companies' employees - \$100.00 per person per class

Class Locations: On our website (*electricalcouncil.com*), there is a link to a map that shows the exact location of each class.

Continuing Education Credit: Each seminar has been approved by the Nebraska State Electrical Board and by the Iowa Electrical Examining Board for six hours of continuing education credit in the code.

All classes count as CODE HOURS. In each state, you are required to take a *minimum* of six hours in the NEC, but you *may take all* of your hours in the NEC. You may take any class more than once and get full credit.
The November 30 class in Omaha focuses more on the design aspects of the NEC, but it is open to anyone in addition to engineers, architects, and designers.

Minimum Enrollment: Each seminar has a minimum enrollment requirement of 25 people. As soon as we reach that number, we will update the website to indicate that the class is a "go".

Confirmation: No confirmation letters will be sent. If you provide an email address, we will send you an email the week of the class as a reminder and to notify you of any changes. If you pay by credit card, you may pick up your credit card receipt when you check in for the class.

Weather: In the event of bad weather, please call the NIEC office anytime (402-483-4483). If the office is not open, an updated recording will inform you of the status of the seminar. You can also check our website (*electricalcouncil.com*) which will be updated immediately if there is a change in class status.
