Class Descriptions

Notes: There are three basics types of classes this fall.

- "**Motors and Motor Wiring**" is based in the 2011 NEC and will cover how motors work, types of motors, circuits, control circuits, and trouble shooting.
- "**2011 NEC Update Seminar**" deals with the changes in the new code book and a variety of issues in using and interpreting the code.
- "**2011 NEC for Engineers, Architects, and Designers**" focuses on the design aspects rather than the installation aspects of the new code. However, anyone is welcome to attend.

Class Locations: On our website, there is a link to a map that shows the exact locations.

• CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDIT: Each seminar has been approved by the Nebraska State Electrical Board and the Iowa Electrical Examining Board for six hours of continuing education credit. All of these classes count towards your CODE requirement. You have a *minimum* number of required credits in the CODE, but you can get *all* of your credits in the CODE, if you wish. Certificates will be provided to all attendees the day of the class.

• In the event of bad weather, please call the NIEC office anytime (402-483-4483). If the office is not open, an updated recording will inform you of the status of the seminar. (We have built-in "snow days" in case we have to reschedule. You can also check the website which will be updated immediately. (www.electricalcouncil.com))

This is a reminder that Nebraska will **NO LONGER HAVE A GRACE PERIOD** in early 2013 with respect to continuing education hours. If you have not earned your required continuing education by December 31, 2012, you will **HAVE TO TAKE THE TEST**. There are no exceptions. If you have earned your continuing education by the end of 2012, you will still have 90 days to renew the actual license. However, your class work will have to be completed by the end of 2012 to avoid taking the test.
